### **COVID PROTOCOL**

Organizer of the event will put in place the Covid protocol following the instructions and requirements from the Finnish Figure Skating Association and local authorities. **Changes can occur also on a short notice – please check frequently for updates.**

Inside the Ice Rink all persons must take the following measures:

- Use of face masks\*. Everyone is responsible of bringing their own masks.
- Frequent washing and disinfection of the hands
- Keep the distance and avoid any kind of gathering
- You must be symptom free to enter the event
- Use only the marked routes and directions to avoid unnecessary contacts

\*) Over 12 years old. Exception: athletes during training and competition

### **MEDAL CEREMONY**

If weather permits, the medal ceremony will be held outdoors outside the ice rink. Final instructions will be announced during the competition.



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPETITORS, COACHES, OFFICIALS, TEAM LEADERS AND OTHER TEAM MEMBERS

The official accreditation point will be at the Ice Rink, from 2pm on February 12th 2022, see above for the door. Competitors and officials must check-in at the accreditation point. Competitors coming from outside Finland must present a valid passport at the accreditation for confirmation of the birthday.

Competitors, Coaches, Team Leaders and other Team Members may arrive one hour before their scheduled warm-up group. Warm-up areas and locker rooms will be indicated at the accreditation/info. In order to limit unnecessary contacts (COVID) Competitors, Coaches, Team Leaders and other Team Members must leave the locker/warm-up areas as soon as possible after the last performance of the day.

Officials may arrive one hour before the competition start.
