2025 HELSINKI, FINLAND FINNISH ICE DANCE OPEN

February 15-16, 2025

The 2025 Finnish Ice Dance Open will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Ice Dance 2024 and the relevant ISU Communications & the Technical Requirements for ISU Supported Adult Figure Skating Competitions 2024-2025 (for Adult Categories).

Participation in the Finnish Ice Dance Open (FIDO), is open to all Competitions who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regards to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and providing they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.



Competition Venue

The Competition will take place at Herttoniemi Ice Rink, Helsinki, Finland. The ice surface is 28 meters by 58 meters with rounded corners. The rink is heated.

Event Requirements

Events offered will be:

- Basic Novice 2 Pattern Dances and 1 Free Dance
- Intermediate Novice 2 Pattern Dances and 1 Free Dance
- Advanced Novice 2 Pattern Dances and 1 Free Dance
- Junior 1 Rhythm Dance and 1 Free Dance
- Senior 1 Rhythm Dance and 1 Free Dance

Adult Categories:

- Masters Elite
- Masters
- Gold
- Silver
- Bronze

The Pattern Dances and Rhythm Dance will be skated prior to the Free Dance.

Age Requirements (met before July 1st preceding the competition):

- Novice:
 - Basic Novice has not reached the age of fourteen
 - \circ $\;$ Intermediate Novice has not reached the age of sixteen
 - Advanced Novice has reached the age of ten and has not reached the age of sixteen for girls and has not reached the age of eighteen for boys.
- Junior has reached the age of thirteen and has not reached the age of twenty-one
- Senior has reached the age of seventeen

Competition Registration

Entries must be submitted to the OC by ISU Members via the electronic Entry Form no later than Sunday January 12th, 2025 to the following email: <u>hsidi.contact@gmail.com</u>. Confirmation of entries will be sent no later than January 13th, 2025. Please do not make any travel arrangements until you receive the confirmation of entries.

Entry Fee

The entry fee for all events will be 110€. The entry fee will be invoiced and sent via e-mail to the clubs after confirmation. The invoice must be paid at latest on the due date: Monday 20th of January 2025. In case of non-payment, the OC reserves the right to consider the pertinent entries withdrawn. In case a skater(s) has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, they can be replaced by another skater(s) in the same category and class until the draw. Participating clubs are asked to inform immediately of any changes in their entries by emailing <u>hsidi.contact@gmail.com</u>. The entry fee will only be refunded in cases when the withdrawal of the skater(s) occurs seven (7) days before the closing date: Friday 24th of January 2025, or upon presentation of an official certificate stating a medical reason preventing the participation.



Entries submitted after the Closing Date, Friday 24th of January 2025, will be subjected to the late entry fee of 125€ and will be treated in order of appearance and subject to the remaining available spots.

Panel of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one judge. The organizer decides on the composition of the panel of judges. In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of judges. The Members concerned will then be notified of the result. The OC will cover the board and lodging for accepted judges and invited officials as of the dinner on the day before the start of their activity until the end of their activity, or for the day when the official is on duty.

The OC will provide and cover the expenses for travel (based on economy fare), rooms and meals in accordance with Finland's general travel policy for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data Operators. Should any Official arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period afore mentioned, the expenses will be their own responsibility and must be paid upon arrival.

The OC will not cover any expenses for Competitors, Team Leaders, Coaches, or Chaperones.

Accommodation

All Teams must cover their accommodation expenses by themselves.

Accreditation

The official accreditation point will be at Herttoniemi Ice Rink from starting from 7am on the Saturday 15th of February, 2025

Accreditations will be given to all Competitors, Coaches, Officials, Team Leaders and other Team Members. An official identity document must be presented at the accreditation for verification.



Accreditation will be made only for skaters whose entry fees have been paid. It is not possible to pay the entry fee on site.

Opening Draw

The Draw will take place electronically on Friday February 14th, 2025 The Starting Order for Free Dances will be the reverse of the Pattern Dances and Rhythm Dances results.

<u>Music</u>

The participating ISU Members and their Clubs are responsible for submitting their skaters' music(s) as a direct attachment to an email to the OC (<u>hsidi.contact@gmail.com</u>) by February 2nd, 2025.

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an emailbased transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC. Each Skater must have their own back-up drive (USB stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or an MP3 file.

The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the OC when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

NB: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

Planned Program Content Sheet

The Program Content Sheet for all categories must be returned to the OC no later than February 2nd, 2025 by e-mail to <u>hsidi.contact@gmail.com</u>. It is mandatory that the Program Content sheet be filled precisely by each Skater in English using the correct terminology.

Presentation of Medals

The first three best placed Competitors in each event will be announced and honored off the ice.

Insurance / Liability

It is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the competition to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance including the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person(s).



The OC assumes no responsibility nor liability with regards to bodily or personal injury nor is the OC liable for any property damage incurred by Competitors or Officials. The OC will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the Competition.

Transportation

The nearest airport to Helsinki is Vantaa Airport (HEL), with a distance of 45 mins approx. to the city center.

Transfer from the airport to the Helsinki main railway station is frequent and easy. Local train lines "I" and "P" take 45mins door to door.
